NOTICE OF ADOPTION OF APPENDIX A

**SUMMARY OF APPENDIX A, THE SANITARY SEWER STANDARDS FOR
THE CONSTITUENT MUNICIPALITIES OF THE SOUTHERN CLINTON
COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITIES AUTHORITY, OF THE ORDINANCE
AMENDING THE WASTEWATER COLLECTION TREATMENT ORDINANCE**

At the regular meeting of the Township Trustees on July 15, 2002, the Watertown Charter Township Board enacted an Ordinance amending the Wastewater Collection and Treatment System Ordinance (“Ordinance”). A portion of that Ordinance (Sections 2 and 3), incorporated changes to the Sanitary Sewer Construction Standards for the Constituent Municipalities of the Southern Clinton County Municipal Utilities Authority (“Sanitary Sewer Construction Standards”). Those Sanitary Sewer Construction Standards were attached in full as Appendix A to the Ordinance. The following is a summary of the Sanitary Sewer Construction Standards attached as Appendix A. A true copy of the Sanitary Sewer Construction Standards is available for inspection at the offices of Watertown Charter Township located at 12803 Wacousta Road, Grand Ledge, Michigan.

GENERAL INFORMATION

The Sanitary Sewer Construction Standards contain the definitions of the meaning of various terms contained in the Sanitary Sewer Construction Standards, identify the regulatory constraints imposed on activities involving the sanitary sewer system by various provisions of State law, set forth the administrative procedures for utility projects and fee schedules, set forth construction standards, and provide a process for administrative variances from the strict requirements of this Sanitary Sewer Construction Standards.

**STANDARDS OF CONSTRUCTION
FOR UTILITY COMPANY CONSTRUCTION**

This section of the Sanitary Sewer Construction Standards set forth those standards that apply to public utility construction within municipal street rights-of-way and sets forth the regulation of construction operations.

STANDARDS OF DESIGN FOR SANITARY SEWERS

This section sets forth those design standards applicable to the construction or repair of sanitary sewers. Included in this section of the Sanitary Sewer Construction Standards is a table of standard materials for use in sanitary sewer construction.

GENERAL CONSTRUCTION REQUIERMENTS

This section of the Sanitary Sewer Construction Standards contains general construction requirements applicable to work on the sanitary sewer system, including provisions governing insurance requirements, superintendence, inspections, boundary marker replacement MISS DIG requirements, and hold harmless requirements, among others. The specifics of the Sanitary Sewer Construction Standards should be consulted for a complete list of all provisions.

TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS

This section of the Sanitary Sewer Construction Standards contains a list of technical specifications as well as an index to those specifications. The specifications set forth address subjects such as, but not limited to, sanitary sewer and force main construction, traffic control, and restoration of adjacent land and roads.

APPENDIX A

The Sanitary Sewer Construction Standards also have attached to them an Appendix A which sets forth sanitary sewer standard details. These details consist of sanitary sewer, sanitary sewer lead, and manhole construction requirements.

APPENDIX B

The Sanitary Sewer Construction Standards also have attached to them an Appendix B, which sets forth Lift Station details. These details consist of layout of structures and equipment, equipment requirements.

MISCELLANEOUS

The Sanitary Sewer Construction Standards rescind previously adopted standards and replace them with the standards in the Sanitary Sewer Construction Standards. In addition, nothing in the Sanitary Sewer Construction Standards shall be construed as a waiver of any Sanitary Sewer ordinance, code, or regulation of the Township or the Township's right to require permittees or persons working on or utilizing the sanitary sewer system to secure appropriate permits or authorizations for construction.
